On Friday, 5 May 2017, our annual Springfest will be organised again in our school.

This year the event celebrates the 60th EU anniversary.

Based on the new Springfest convention signed between the APEEE and the School in July 2016, the Springfest Committee decided to honour on this occasion a number of non-profit associations, who will be donated part of Springfest proceeds. Thus, our school's social responsibility forms "bridges" with citizens across Europe. They will be present at our school from 9h till 15h.

### Gala Concert

Tuesday, 2 May 2017 (19:00 - 21:00)

The Gala Concert aims to allow students to present their various talents. The event is organised in the teachers' canteen.

### Opening Ceremony

Thursday, 4 May 2017 (20:00 - 22:00, entrance from 18:30)

On Thursday evening, the Opening Ceremony entitled "Fairy tales" will take place for all parents at 20 hrs. Parents will be allowed to enter the school from 18:30 onwards.

A possibility to eat and drink something will be offered from 18h30 and after the performance.

### Springfest Day

Friday, 5 May 2017 (08:30 - 00:30)

Q&A session with students debating on the future of the EU will take place in the theatre at 11 am. The keynote speaker will be **Mr Ceramicola**.

A wide range of enjoyable activities are arranged by and for the students and includes fun games for the younger students, diverse performances and shows, parades, football, live music and food stands in Eurovillage with delicious flavours of different culinary traditions.

### APEEE and OIB services on friday, 5 May:

**1. Extracurricular activities:** No activities will take place on that day.

**2. Transport:**

- The usual Friday 1st departure buses at 15.35 will run usual as well as the garderie buses of 12.30 and 15.35.
- The usual Friday 2nd departure buses are **cancelled**.

**3. Canteen:** There will be no normal canteen or cafeteria service today.

**BUT, please note the following:**

- Pupils in Nursery, P1 and P2 who are usually enrolled for the canteen on Friday will be offered a sandwich lunch.
- Pupils from P3 to S7 must either bring in a packed lunch from home or buy their lunch from the food stands (Eurovillage, BBQ, etc.).

**4. Garderie:** The usual Friday time-schedule and service will apply.

### Buying tickets and bracelets

The price for a ticket is 1 Euro. Goods' prices remain at the same level as in 2015. We are offering single tickets (1€) as well as cards for the price of **5€, 10€ and 20€** in the following ways.

This year the APEEE has made it possible to buy tickets and bracelets on-line. These tickets give you the right to buy food, drinks and access to the games. Primary and nursery pupils can buy tickets in their classes (cash payments) on Tuesday, 2 May, as indicated below.

On Springfest day (5 May 2017), you will also be able to buy your tickets using cash or (at some stands) electronic payment.

### Tickets collection and pre-sale

Ticket must either be collected and bought (cash / electronic payment):

- Outside the APEEE office on **Tuesday, 2 and Thursday, 4 May 2017, from 8:00 till 14:00**
- Outside the gym for opening ceremony tickets only on **Thursday from 18.30**
- At the designated Pre-sales stand on **Friday, 5 May 2017, from 8:00 till 16:00**

For on-line ticket collection, please bring your order number and a piece of identity (school 'D' card is sufficient if your child is collecting).

### Distribution of tickets in nursery and primary classes

Parents of children in Nursery and Primary order tickets and bracelets as explained below (**Nursery letter, P12 letter, P345 letter**). The form must be printed, completed and returned to the classroom with the **exact** money (or the proof of the e-payment) on **Tuesday, 2 May**. Teams of volunteers will pass by each classroom collecting the money and distributing tickets on that day only.
